But if God so clothes the grass in the field, which is alive today and tomorrow is thrown into the furnace, how much more will He clothe you? You men of little faith!

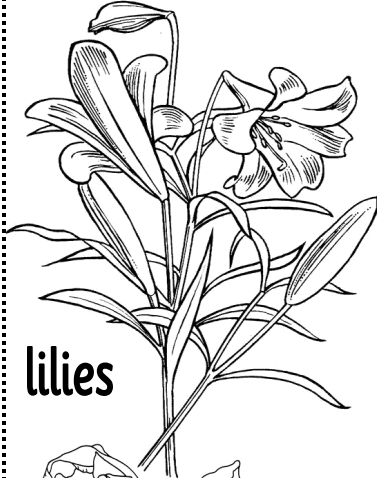

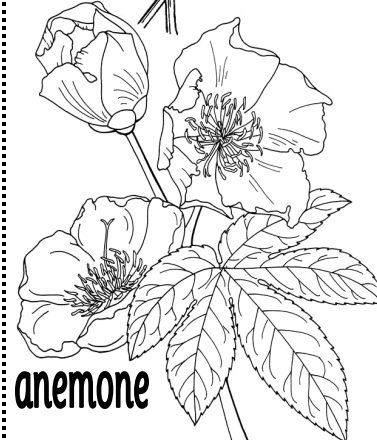

Consider the Lilies






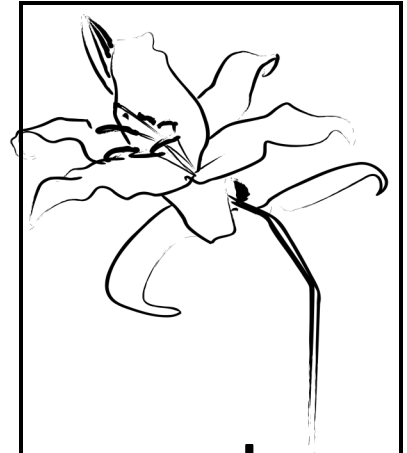
irrigate

To make dry land fertile by watering; To supply water by means of ditches, canals or streams.



plowing

To break and turn up earth with a plow.



muzzle

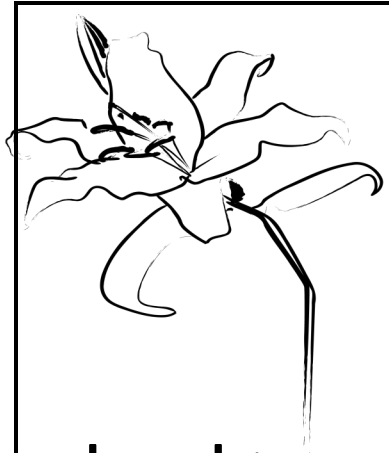
A device used to cover an animal's mouth to keep it from biting or eating.

Color, cut, memorize vocabulary and store in pocket.



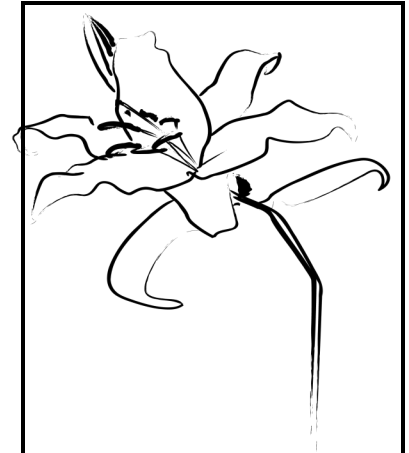
gleaning

To gather what ever portion of crops was left over by the harvesters. The harvesters could leave some part of the crop out intentionally or unintentionally.



threshing

The process of taking or releasing the grain from it's stalk. Normally this was done on a threshing floor to be sure the grain kernels are broken from the chaff. *(thin covering or husks on kernels like on wheat and barley.)*



winnowing

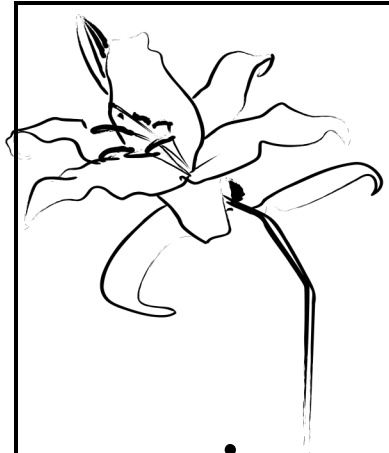
Winnowing is the next step in separating grains. The whole mixture (chaff, straw, and kernels) is tossed in the air against the wind. A strong evening wind blows the chaff away, the straw separates to the side and the kernels fall back down to the floor.

Color, cut, memorize vocabulary and store in pocket.



grinding

Final step to turn the grains into flour. This can be done by a pestle and mortar, rubbing it on a stone slab or by a hand mill. This was generally done by the women.



sowing

In Bible times, it is the method for scattering seeds on the earth. This was done by *broadcasting*. The sower carried seed and dispersed the seed before him in a long sweeping motion.



reaping

In Bible times, harvesting the grain sometimes by hand pulling the roots from the soil or by using a sickle to cut the grain. (a sickle is a curved tool used for cutting)



Sickle
