
Fold back and down. Glue this to back of note-book page or file folder.




Pop Up Book Cover


Book 1. Cut out on black lines fold hamburger style and crease real good.


After you cut tabs for pop ups in Book 2, add pop ups and decorate your background on Book 2, then glue Book 2 inside of Book 1 on crease. BE SURE NOT TO GLUE YOUR POP UPS. (Beginners Tip: Place glue on Book two edge and NOT Book 1 where is it easier to do.)

Book 1 does not have tabs cut in it, it is a cover page only.

Pop up 1 goes on the left side inside of Book 2

Pop up 2 goes on the right side inside of book.

Cut out Book 2 on outside black lines. Fold in half hamburger style.

With book folded, cut two tabs slightly in and fold tab in and crease good. Open book and push tabs to the inside to form the base the pop ups will be glued to.

(Beginners tips: You are not cutting all the way through, just slightly in. However, each pair of tabs needs to be the same length, but you decide how far in each tab is. So for two tabs, you will have 4 cuts in toward the middle. Neither are you cutting horizontal. Your cut is only vertical. To make one object be behind another, cut one tab(2 cuts) in shorter than the other tab. Then one object will be closer to the foreground and one object will be closer the background.

Then create your own background at the top half of the paper. Draw your own scenery with map pencils, draw part and use part of the clipart on the next page or use only the clip art.

Color pop ups, and glue them to the inside of Book Two after you decorate. Let dry for a minute or two before you glue inside to Book 1.

Be sure to decorate the bottom of Book 2 around your pop ups.

One more option:

Use ANY of the clipart on the next page for pop ups .
