


*Railroad ~

*Timeline*


*1825* Erie Canal is completed. It links Lake Erie to the Hudson River.

*1850* 900 miles of track laid in twenty five states east of the Mississippi River. Theodore Judah dreams of building a transcontinental Railroad.

*1863* The race between the Central Pacific and Union Pacific railroad officially began.

*1869* May 10, transcontinental railroad meets at Promontory Summit, Utah.




Option :
