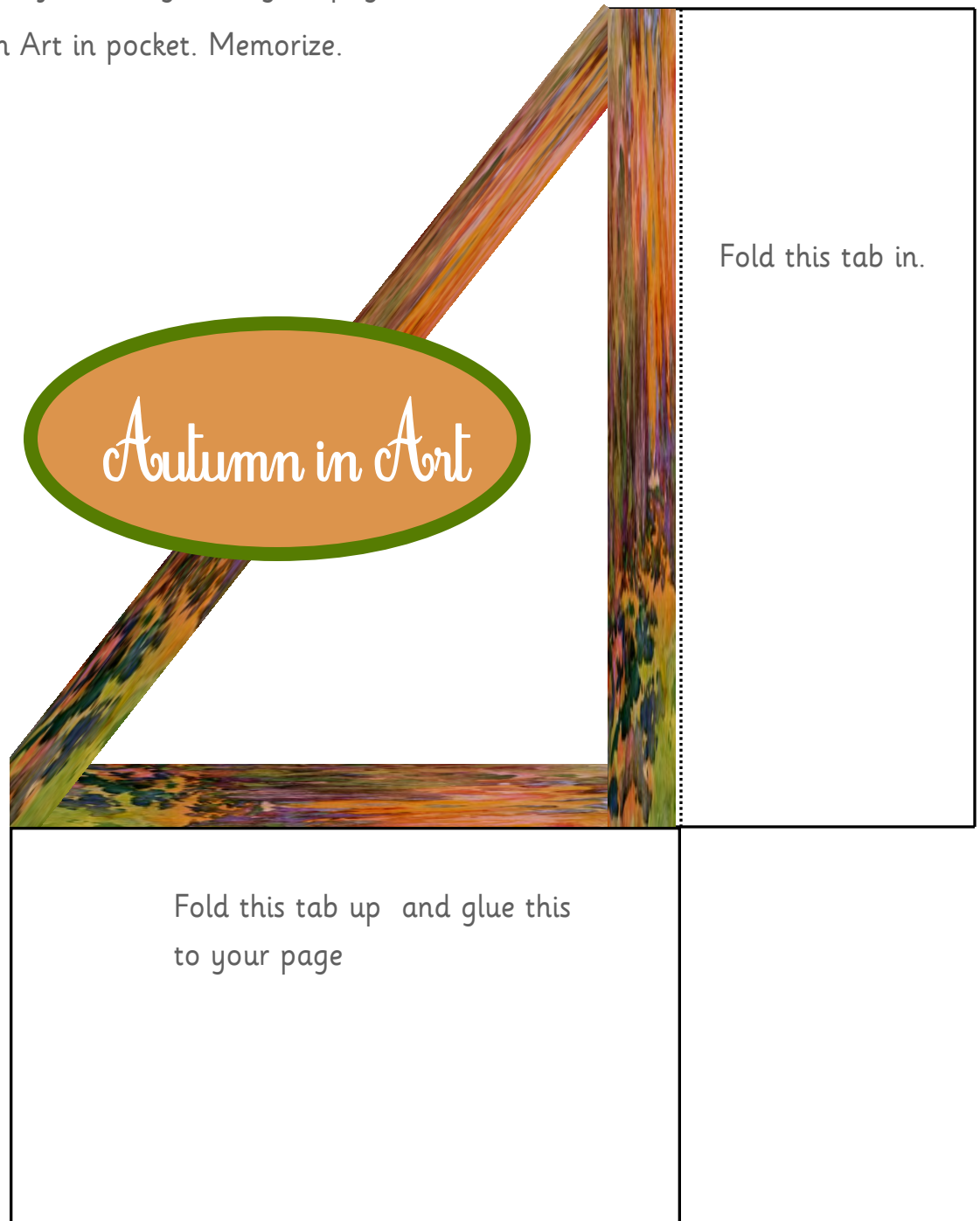

Artist Name: Albert Bierstadt



Best known for his lavish, sweeping landscapes of the American West.

When? 1830 - 1902

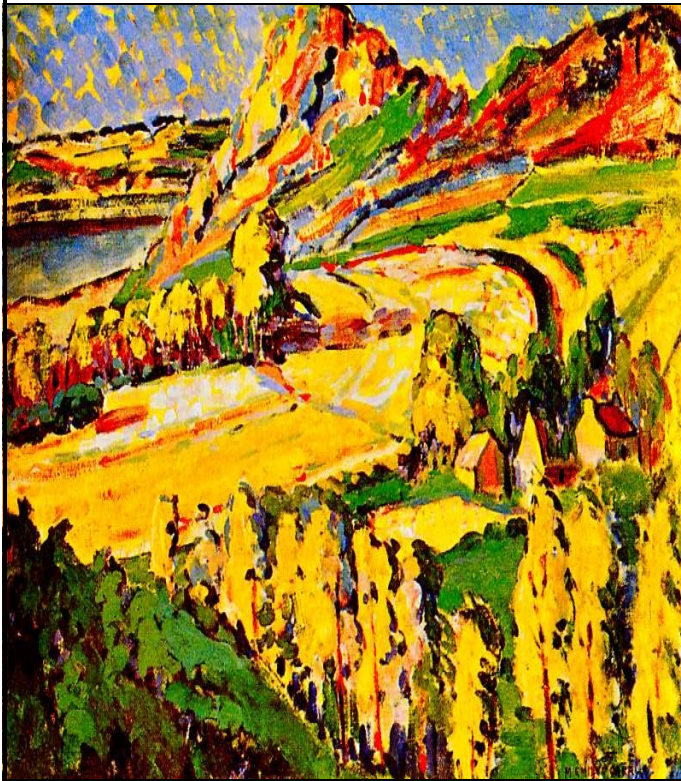
Artist Name: Giuseppe Arcimboldo



Best known for creating imaginative portrait heads made entirely of such objects as fruits, vegetables, flowers, fish, and books.

Who? Italian Painter
When? 1527 - 1593

Autumn in France



Artist Name: Emily Carr



One of the first painters in Canada to adopt a post-impressionist style. She was inspired by the indigenous peoples of the Pacific Northwest Coast.

Who? Canadian artist, painter, and writer
When? 1871 - 1945

Four Seasons: Autumn



Artist Name: Nicolas Poussin



His work predominantly features clarity, logic, and order, and favors line over color. This portrait is of the spies with the grapes of the Promised Land.

Who? French painter in the classical style
When? 1594 - 1665

American Homestead Autumn



Artist Name: Currier and Ives



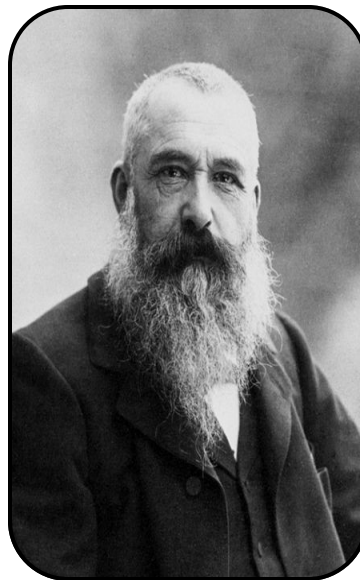
Best known as creators of popular art prints, such as landscapes and depictions of Victorian urban scenes. Currier & Ives also produced political cartoons and banners and significant historical scenes.

Who? American Lithographers
When? 1813 - 1888

Four Seasons: Autumn



Artist Name: Claude Monet



He was the founder of French Impressionism and the term "Impressionism" comes from his painting *Impression, Sunrise*.

Who? French Impressionist Painter
When? 1840 - 1926
