# Artist Name: Giuseppe Arcimboldo




Best known for creating imaginative portrait heads made entirely of such objects as fruits, vegetables, flowers, fish, and books.

## Artist Name: Nicolas Poussin




His work predominantly features clarity, logic, and order, and favors line over color. This portrait is of the spies with the grapes of the Promised Land.




### Artist Name: Currier and Ives




Best known as creators of popular art prints, such as landscapes and depictions of Victorian urban scenes. Currier & Ives also produced political cartoons and banners and significant historical
