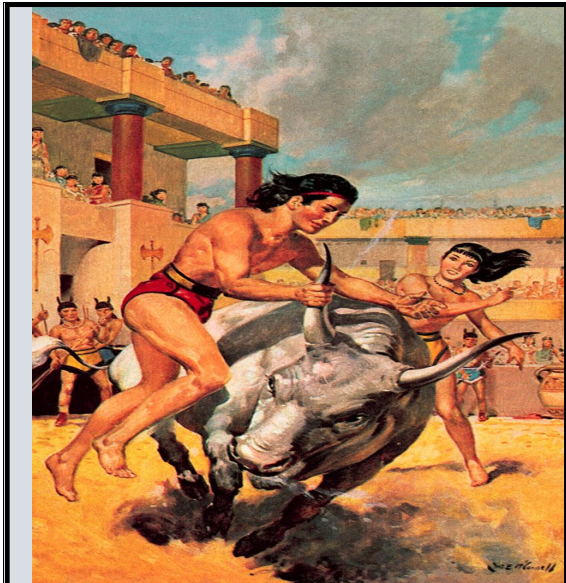
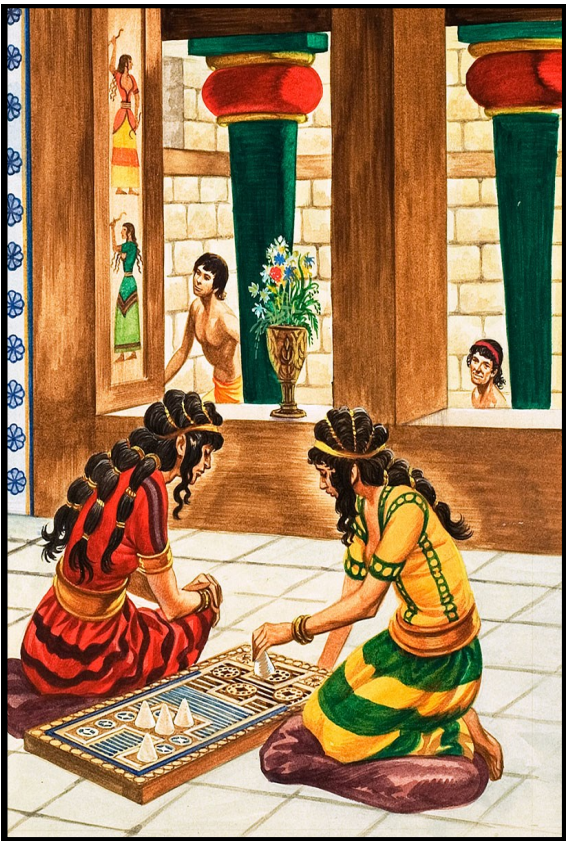
The bull was regarded by the Minoans as a sacred animal. Daring bull sports were performed at the in the capital city of Knossos.
