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INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE.

Use page one for your child to mark the Trail of Tears. As some suggestions and according to your child's age, you can require him to mark landmarks, label states, and other geographical features such as the Mississippi River and Ohio River, which had to be crossed on the trail.

The second page is for a younger learner of geography. There is enough room to write the states, Atlantic Ocean and Gulf of Mexico after they locate them on their U.S. atlas.

After they are finished, either add these pages to their notebook or fold each page minibook style and glue in their lapbook. Look at my picture where I show you how to turn ordinary worksheets into fun minibooks.
