Fold on dotted lines, cut on solid line.

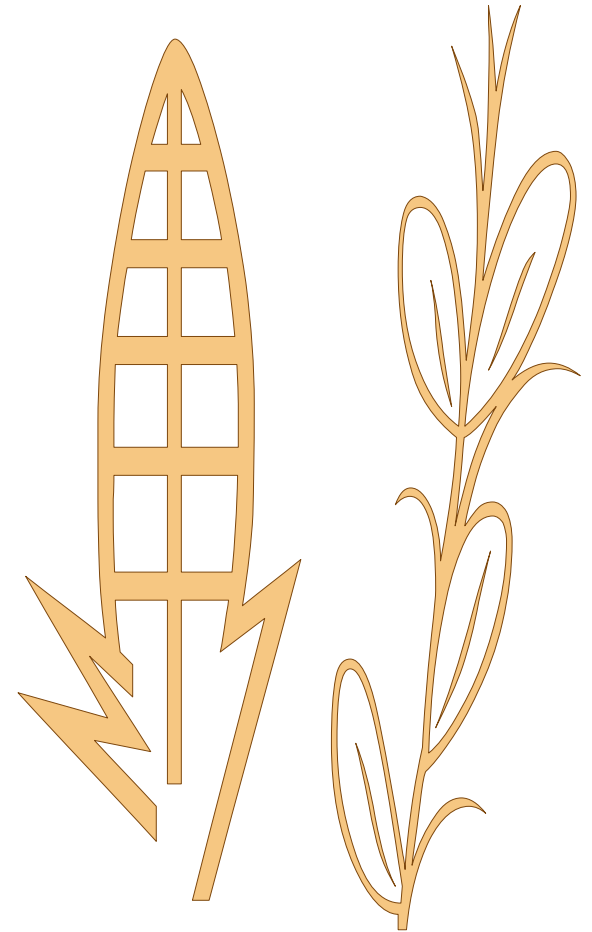
Trifold.

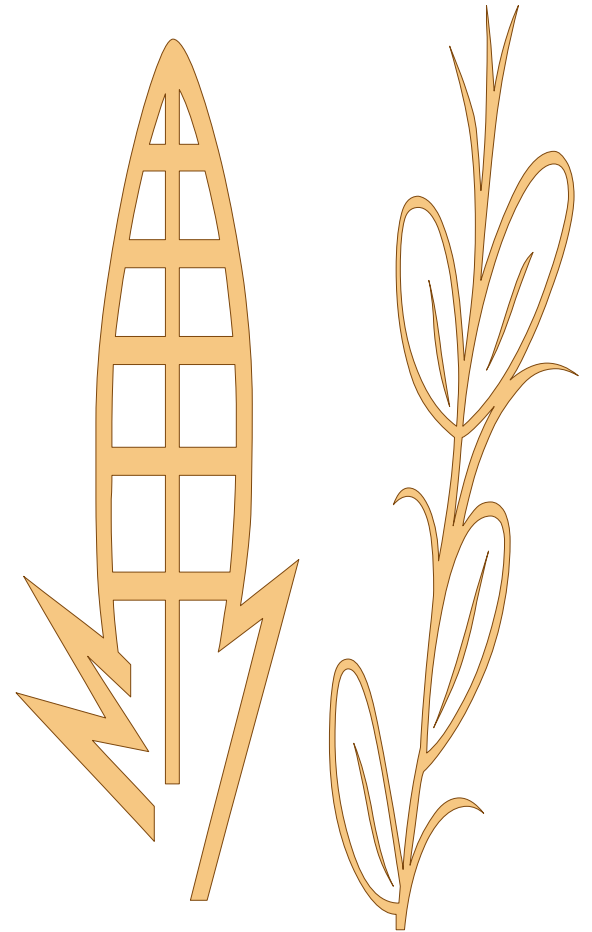
