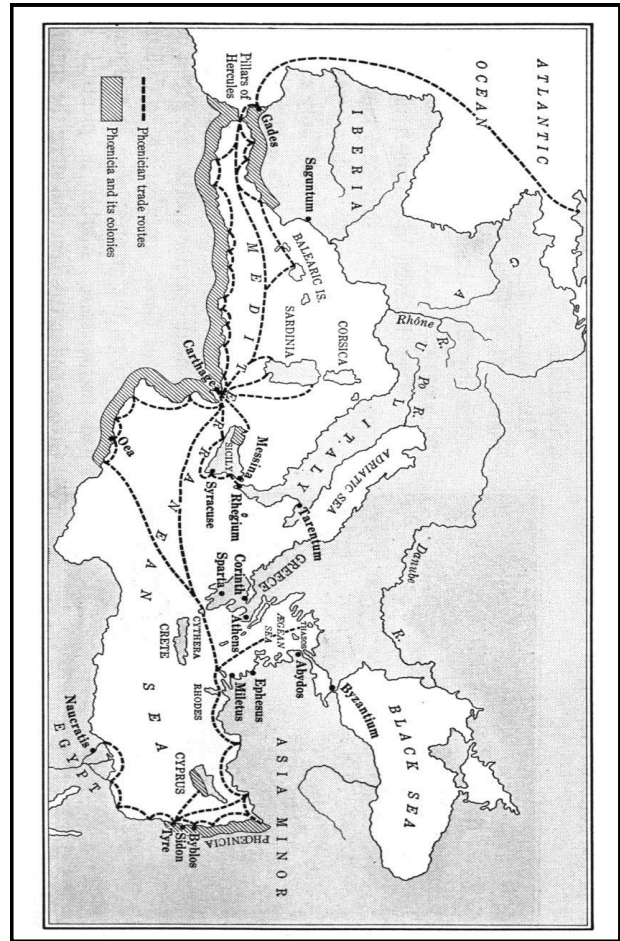


Phoenicians *Sailors & Traders*

Phoenicians lived in what is present day Lebanon. Unlike the Mesopotamians they were ship builders, sailors and traders.

They established the cities of Sidon and Tyre. The Phoenicians traded in Africa and took wine, olive oil and pottery.

Sailing the seas they also took cedar wood from Lebanon's forest and purple dye from sea snail shells.

Phoenician metalworkers were skilled in engraving gold and silver objects. Some of them specialized in carving wood, ivory and glassware.

The Phoenicians settled in Cyprus, Crete and North Africa.
